

## ANGIE INTEGRATIONS OVERVIEW

Below is a summary of available Angie integrations and the benefits they add for hotels and their guests.

### Sonifi



- Turn TV off/on by voice
- Turn TV off/on via UI\*
- Change channel by channel name  
(i.e., “Hey, Angie. Change channel to ESPN.”)
- Change channel up or down to scan stations
- Turn volume up/down and mute

### Amadeus Service Optimization (HotSOS)



- Initiate requests from Angie directly into defined hotel workflows
- Coordinate requests for room items  
(e.g., towels, soap, razors) to be sent to room
- Submit maintenance requests  
(e.g., faucet leaking, dresser drawer sticking, fridge handle loose)

## Telkonet



- Ability to set thermostat to desired temperature by voice
- Ability to set thermostat to desired temperature by touch UI\*
- Set the thermostat to efficient settings automatically upon check-out, which can result in significant energy savings\*\*
- Ability to set preferred settings at check-in\*\*
- Change thermostat mode to heat or cool via voice or UI

## Honeywell INNCOM



- Ability to control configured in-room automation of lights and curtains/drapes via voice
- Lights can be controlled individually or all at once
- Lights can be controlled via UI\*
- Lights can be dimmed (e.g., "Hey, Angie. Set the bedroom lamp to 50 percent.")

## INTEREL



- Ability to control "scenes" with numerous actions at once, such as the command "Hey, Angie. Movie time." This can be used to close the drapes and turn down the lights to 20% all at once.
- The most common examples of in-room settings that can be activated include lights, the thermostat and curtains/drapes
- Lights can be controlled individually or all at once
- Lights can be controlled via UI\*
- Lights can be dimmed (e.g., "Hey, Angie. Set the bedroom lamp to 50 percent.")

## PMS

- Ability to view bill from UI\*
- Ability to check out from Angie in-room assistants
- Display privacy policy that must be accepted before voice usage\*
- Clear device personal information automatically at check-out (i.e., if guest connected a personal device to play music via bluetooth, this information will be cleared permanently)
- Angie can be configured to only allow check-out during specified hours
